Dr. Chad Hart

Associate professor, Iowa State University

Dr. Hart will be discussing the current state of crops, as well as what the fall looks like for Midwest agriculture.

Prior to joining the ISU faculty as an Associate Professor of Economics, Dr. Hart was the U.S. Policy and Insurance Analyst with the Food and Agricultural Policy Research Institute (FAPRI) and a Scientist with the Center for Agricultural and Rural Development (CARD) at Iowa State University. For FAPRI, he was responsible for directing econometric and modeling efforts for the crop insurance component of the FAPRI modeling system and he has engaged in research examining the interaction between the agricultural commitments within the World Trade Organization (WTO) and the agricultural policies and programs of WTO members. For CARD, Dr. Hart served as head of the Biorenewables Policy Division and examined the interactions between the agricultural and energy sectors.
